The deadline for applying for Theda Rehbock's Philosophy Residency in Susimetsa, Pärnu County, Estonia is October 15, 2024.

Susimetsa *Philosophicum* welcomes graduate students, solo researchers or small groups (up to 4 people) to apply for a writing retreat in Susimetsa. Here, you can dedicate your time to crafting a philosophical paper, preparing a grant proposal or advancing work on a book, all while residing in the spacious villa bequeathed to Susimetsa *Philosophicum* by Theda Rehbock, the German philosopher and bioethicist, a former guest professor of Tartu University.

The applicant has the freedom to choose the time and duration of the residency, which can be anywhere between **1 to 4 weeks from November 2024 to April 2025.** Each year up to 8 scholarships are awarded. For more information: https://susimetsa.ee/residency/

The spacious villa with a philosophical library (most of the books are in German), piano, music centre, high-speed wifi, office with a beautiful view at the garden, private lake, are at the resident's disposal. Living in Susimetsa villa is free. Residents pay for additional costs (e.g., use of sauna and hot tub) and they are responsible for their own transportation and food during the residency. The nearest supermarket is situated 5 km away, and the closest cafebakery is just 1.7 km away. Susimetsa is 17 km from Pärnu and 162 km from Tartu.
